Ordinance amending the San Francisco Health Code, Article 3, Section 128 to set patient rates and other services provided by the Department of Public Health, effective July 1, 2011.

Section 1. Findings.

A. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 110708 and is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The San Francisco Health Code is hereby amended by amending Section 128, to read as follows:

Sec. 128. PATIENT RATES. (a) The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby determine and fix the proper reasonable amounts to be charged to persons for services furnished by the Department of Public Health as follows, which rates shall be effective for services delivered as of ~~July 1, 2010~~ July 1, 2011.

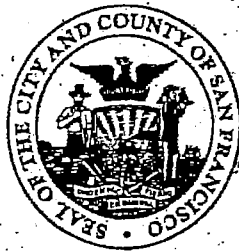
Existing Law
