

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - North Valley Consortium Workforce Development
2 Board - Prison to Employment Initiative - \$387,105]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of Economic and Workforce**
4 **Development to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$387,105 from the Bay-**
5 **Peninsula Regional Planning Unit fiscal agent, the North Valley Consortium Workforce**
6 **Development Board, for expansion of an in-custody job center and coordination of**
7 **post-release job training and workforce development programs, for the period of**
8 **September 1, 2019, through March 31, 2022.**

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10 WHEREAS, The California Workforce Development Board Prison to Employment
11 Initiative seeks to fund training opportunities and supportive services for reentry and justice-
12 involved individuals; and

13 WHEREAS, The Bay-Peninsula Regional Planning Unit Prison to Employment Initiative
14 application identified a strategy for the expansion of an in-custody job center and coordination
15 of in-custody and post-release services among reentry partners; and

16 WHEREAS, The Bay-Peninsula Regional Planning Unit, acting as a pass-through
17 agent, granted the Office of Economic and Workforce Development \$387,105 to develop
18 training programs and supportive services for reentry and justice-involved individuals; and

19 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; and

20 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on
21 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That North Valley Consortium (NOVA) Workforce Development Board is
23 the Bay-Peninsula Regional Planning Unit fiscal agent for funding from the California
24 Workforce Development Board; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of
2 Economic and Workforce Development to accept and expend a grant in the amount of
3 \$387,105 from the Bay-Peninsula Regional Planning Unit fiscal agent, the North Valley
4 Consortium (NOVA) Workforce Development Board; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Office of Economic and Workforce Development is
6 responsible for the oversight of Bay-Peninsula Regional Planning Unit State funding for
7 workforce development activities in San Francisco; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
9 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of the Office of Economic and Workforce
11 Development is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City.
