9 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the Governor and
10 Legislature to fully fund the California AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) and reject an
11 enrollment cap; and, be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors directs our Clerk
13 to forward a copy of this resolution to the Governor and members of our state legislative
14 delegation.
