DIRECTING THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO INVITE THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO PLAN FOR FLEET WEEK 2000, IN ORDER TO DISCUSS FLIGHT PATTERNS FOR THE BLUE ANGELS.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has celebrated fleet week for decades, by inviting the U.S. Navy and its precision flying team, the Blue Angels, to hold an air show for the benefit of City and Bay Area residents; and,

WHEREAS, Impressive though they are, the Blue Angels often scare or disturb City residents – particularly in residential neighborhoods – when they fly low overhead; and,

WHEREAS, During Fleet Week, countless residents call City offices to express their concerns about the Blue Angels' low flying over residential areas and their fear of potential accidents; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby directs the Clerk of the Board to invite representatives from the United States Department of the Navy to hold public hearings in the City to plan for Fleet Week 2000 in order to discuss flight patterns for the Blue Angels.
