Karl Hasz is a current member of the Historic Preservation Commission, and previously served on the Landmarks Preservation Board. Karl is the president and founder of Hasz Construction, Inc., a commercial general contracting firm based in San Francisco completing acclaimed restaurant projects within historic structures.

A few of Karl's most prized preservation projects include Bacar Restaurnat, Tres Agaves, as well as Farina. Both Bacar and Tres Agaves, located in the SOMA district, were design ad built to accent the existing brick buildings individual characteristics as they were when originally built at the turn of the twentieth century. Tres Agaves was created within a building that was completed in 1898 and was originally a working firehouse. Farina was built within a mid-century building housing a classic neighborhood bakery. Many elements, including the original signage & equipment, were reused in the design and function of the restaurant.
