Gwen Henry, succeeding Fran Kipnis, (Seat No. 16, Must be nominee of the Mayor and represent the public at large), unexpired portion of three-year term ending April 1, 2000;

Edna Hazard, succeeding herself, (Seat No. 20, Must be nominee of the Board of Education and a client of publicly-subsidized child care program), for a new three-year term ending April 1, 2002;

Maria Luz Torre, (Seat No. 21, Must be nominee of the Board of Education and a consumer of Department of Human Services child care program services), for a new three-year term ending April 1, 2002;

Sue Humbert-Rico, succeeding Jim Hopper, (Seat No. 23, Must be nominee of the Board of Education and represent the local district office of Community Care Licensing), for a new three-year term ending April 1, 2002;

Marie Salgado, succeeding herself, (Seat No. 24, Must be nominee of the Board of Education and represent organized educators), for a new three-year term ending April 1, 2002;

Stephen Santos Rico, succeeding Kate Danforth, (Seat No. 25, Must be nominee of the Board of Education and represent local public educational training institution), for a new three-year term ending April 1, 2002;

Michele Rutherford, (Seat No. 30, Must be nominee of the Mayor and representative of the Department of Human Services), for a new three-year term ending April 1, 2002.

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- Applicant Stephen Santos Rico, an appointee, who is not a resident of San
  Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies him to serve on the
  Child Care Planning and Advisory Council.
