12 WHEREAS, Ten million trees have been planted nationally as a direct result of
13 American Forests' Global ReLeaf campaign; and,

14 WHEREAS, In recognition of this historic achievement, Balance Bar Company is
15 sponsoring a nationwide campaign to thank those who have supported the Global ReLeaf
16 campaign and to educate children about the importance of planting trees; and,

17 WHEREAS, The national kick-off event will take place in San Francisco at Ferry Plaza


