

1 [Expanding Eligible Participation for PERS]  
2 SUPPORTING AB 2285, WHICH WOULD ALLOW NONPROFITS WHO PROVIDE  
3 REHABILITATION SERVICES FOR DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED PERSONS TO  
4 PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM UPON RECEIPT  
5 OF AN ADVISORY OPINION FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.

6 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is committed to promoting quality care for  
7 the developmentally disabled; and,

8 WHEREAS, In this healthy economy, where employers must offer competitive compensation,  
9 hiring and retention of staff within rehabilitation facilities has become a challenge; and,

10 WHEREAS, CalPERS is this nation's largest public pension fund, providing a defined benefit  
11 pension for employees of more than 2,400 public employers throughout the state, serving as a multiple-  
12 employer public employee retirement system acting as a common investment and administrative  
13 agent for California public employers; and,

14 WHEREAS, AB 2285 would expand the definition of agencies eligible to participate in  
15 CalPERS to include nonprofits who provide rehabilitation services for developmentally disabled  
16 persons, upon receipt of an advisory opinion from the Department of Labor; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby support AB 2285; and, be it,

18 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby ask that copies of this  
19 resolution be sent to His Honor the Mayor and to our state representatives with instructions to take all  
20 possible actions to promote the successful passage of AB 2285; to Assemblyman Dean Florez, Capitol  
21 Building, Rm. 5135, Sacramento, CA 95814; and to Senator Jim Costa, Capitol Building, Rm. 5100,  
22 Sacramento, CA 95814.


