WHEREAS, An Annual Salary Ordinance amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH for five existing positions, one Senior Industrial Hygienist (Job Class No. 6139) at .019 FTE, one IS Business Analyst (Job Class No. 1052) at .038 FTE, one Senior Environmental Health Inspector (Job Class No. 6122) at .211 FTE, one Senior Environmental Health Inspector (Job Class No. 6122) at .154 FTE, and one Senior Environmental Health Inspector (Job Class No. 6122) at .154 FTE, for the period of January 1, 2010 through March 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Certified Unified Program Agency Electronic Reporting grant does not allow for indirect costs to maximize use of grant funds on direct services; and

WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City.
