# Overview of Contract Amendment #1



**Contractor:** Crestwood Behavioral Health, Inc.

**Contract Amendment Amount:** \$17,192,029

- **Not-to-Exceed Amount:** \$26,255,566

**Timeline:** Total term of March 1, 2025, through June 30, 2028

- Extends contract term by 2 years

**Contract Summary:** The Crisis Stabilization Unit at 822 Geary provides 24/7 voluntary, medically staffed crisis services.

# Program Summary



## Summary:

- Designed for rapid stabilization of acute mental health symptoms and serves as a designated drop-off site for first responders.
- The program serves as a Local Emergency Medical Services Agency (LEMSA) designated Triage to Alternative Destination (TAD) authorized to receive ambulances responding to 911 calls for behavioral health emergencies.

**Certification:** *Crisis Stabilization Unit* by the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS).

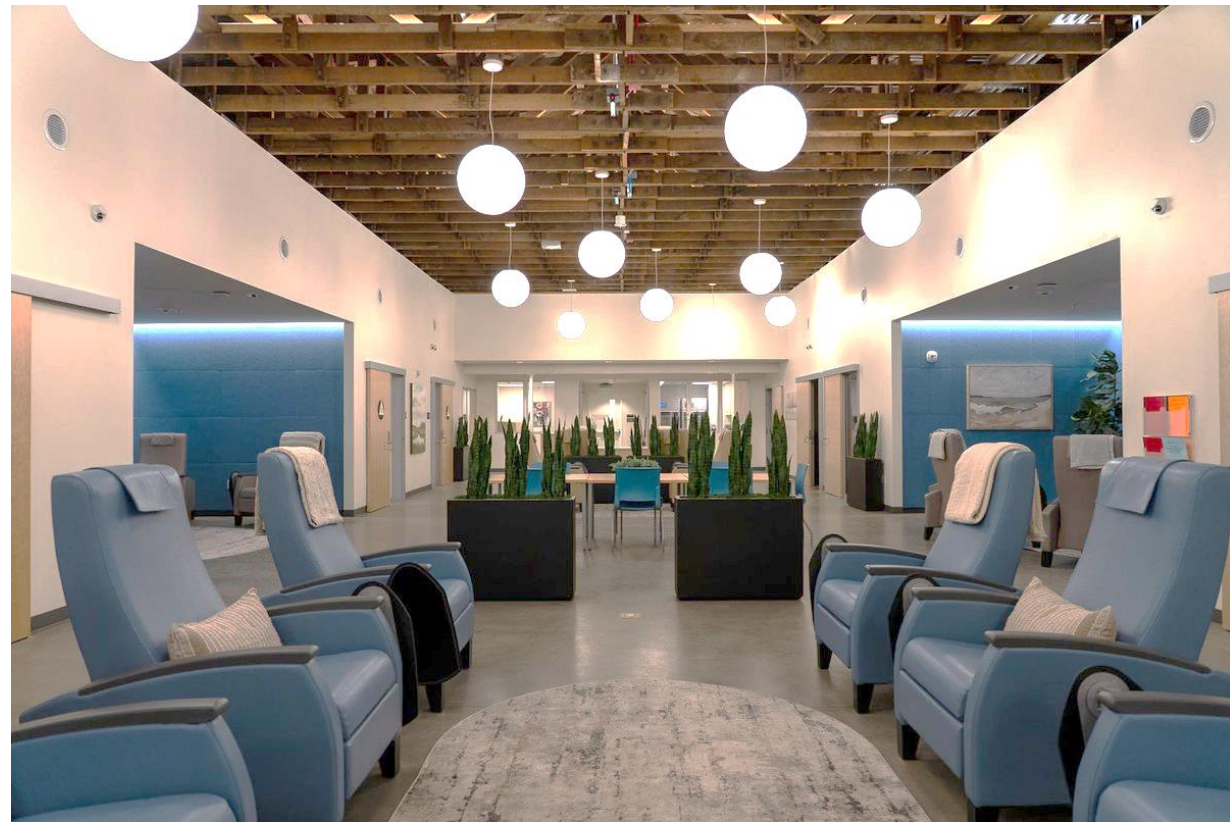
**Funding Sources:** Funded by Prop C and Medi-Cal reimbursement.

**Services Provided:** Psychiatric assessment, crisis intervention and counseling, medication assessment and management, treatment coordination, and discharge planning.
