2 APPROVING THE IDENTIFIED FUNDING PRIORITIES FOR THE NEW CALIFORNIA
3 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION RECOMMENDED BY THE SAN FRANCISCO CHILD CARE
4 PLANNING AND ADVISORY COUNCIL AND ALL THE LOCAL CHILD CARE PLANNING
5 COUNCILS.

6 WHEREAS, On July 29, 1998, the California Department of
7 Education requested recommendations from the San Francisco Child Care
8 Planning and Advisory Council (CCPAC) and all the local child-care
9 planning councils (LPC) in the state to identify county priorities
10 for new California Department of Education child care funding; and,

11 WHEREAS, CCPAC gathered comprehensive data and identified the
12 areas most under-served by current state and federal funds for
13 general child care services for infants and toddlers and for State
14 Preschool program; and,

15 WHEREAS, The county priorities identified are 94102, 94108,
16 94109, 94110, 94112, 94122, 94124, 94133, and 94134; and,

17 WHEREAS, The California Department of Education will attach the
18 county priorities to the Request for Applications for these new child
19 care funds, allowing applicants to know which areas have been
20 identified as under-served areas; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of City and County of
22 San Francisco approves the identified funding priorities recommended
23 by the San Francisco Child Care Planning and Advisory Council and all
24 the local child care planning councils.




