13	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving these funds, PHFE requires SFDPH to enter		
14	into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of		
15	Supervisors in File No. 060094; which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if		
16	set forth fully herein; and,		
17	WHEREAS, The terms of the contract agreement prohibit including indirect costs in the		
18	grant budget; now, therefore, be it		
19	RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a contract		
20	agreement in the amount of \$141,413 with PHFE, the primary contractor; and, be it		
21	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of		
22	indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it		
23	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter retroactively		
24	into the agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions		
2	funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate whe		
3	the agreement expires.
