7 profit cooperative; and

9 WHEREAS, The Synergy School has been a leader in the pioneering peer-based  
10 learning within a supportive multi-cultural environment for elementary and middle school  
11 children and adolescents; and

12 WHEREAS, Through a peer-based model, the School has successfully fostered self-  
13 confidence, cooperation, creativity, and multi-cultural competency within its students for more  
14 than three decades; and

16 WHEREAS, Community involvement has been integral part of the success of the  
17 school and involving parents, neighbors, the philanthropic and business community in raising  
18 funds for scholarships, extracurricular and recreational activities for students; now, therefore,  
19 be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commends the Synergy School on its 31<sup>st</sup>  
21 anniversary and declares February 12, 2005 as “Synergy School Day” in the City and County
