

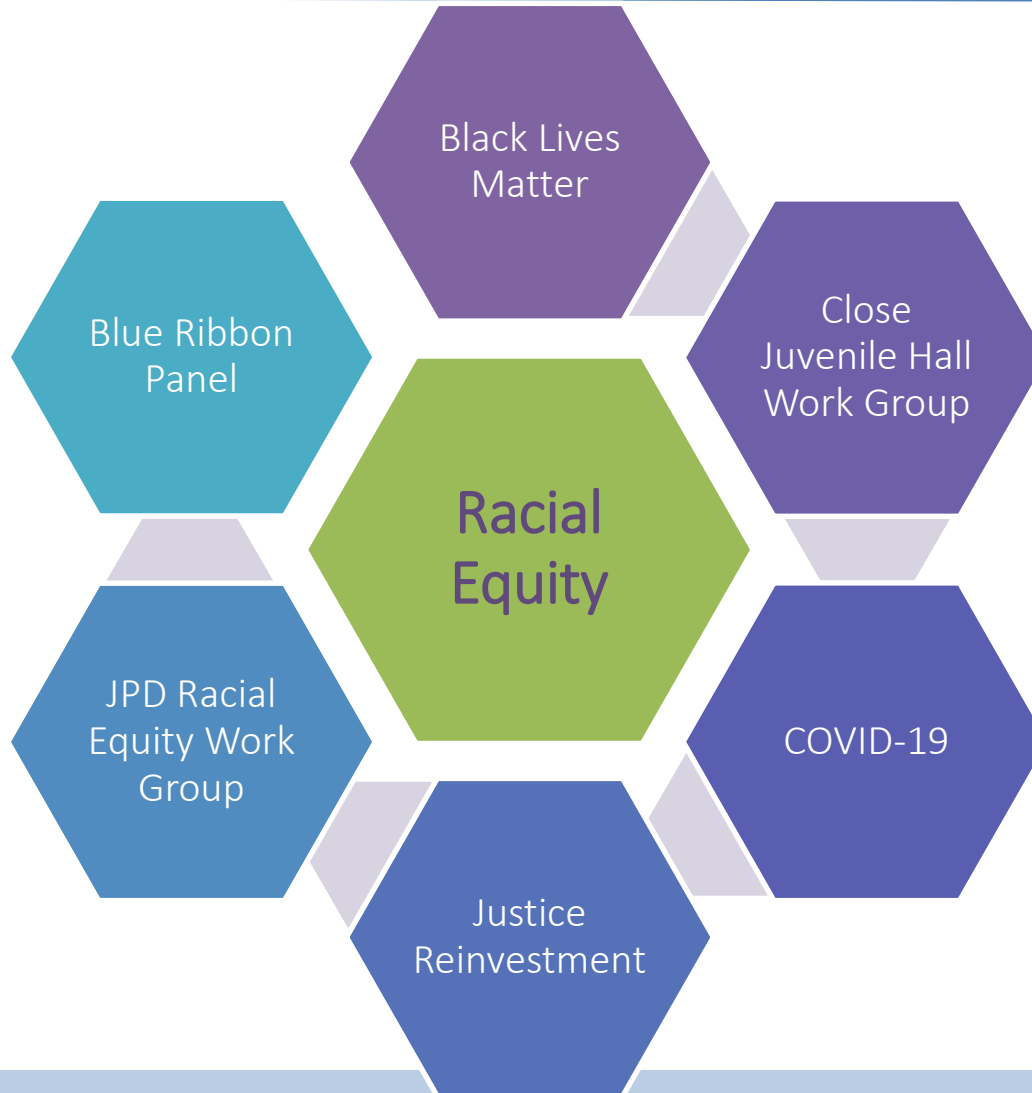

Historic Moment for Juvenile Justice

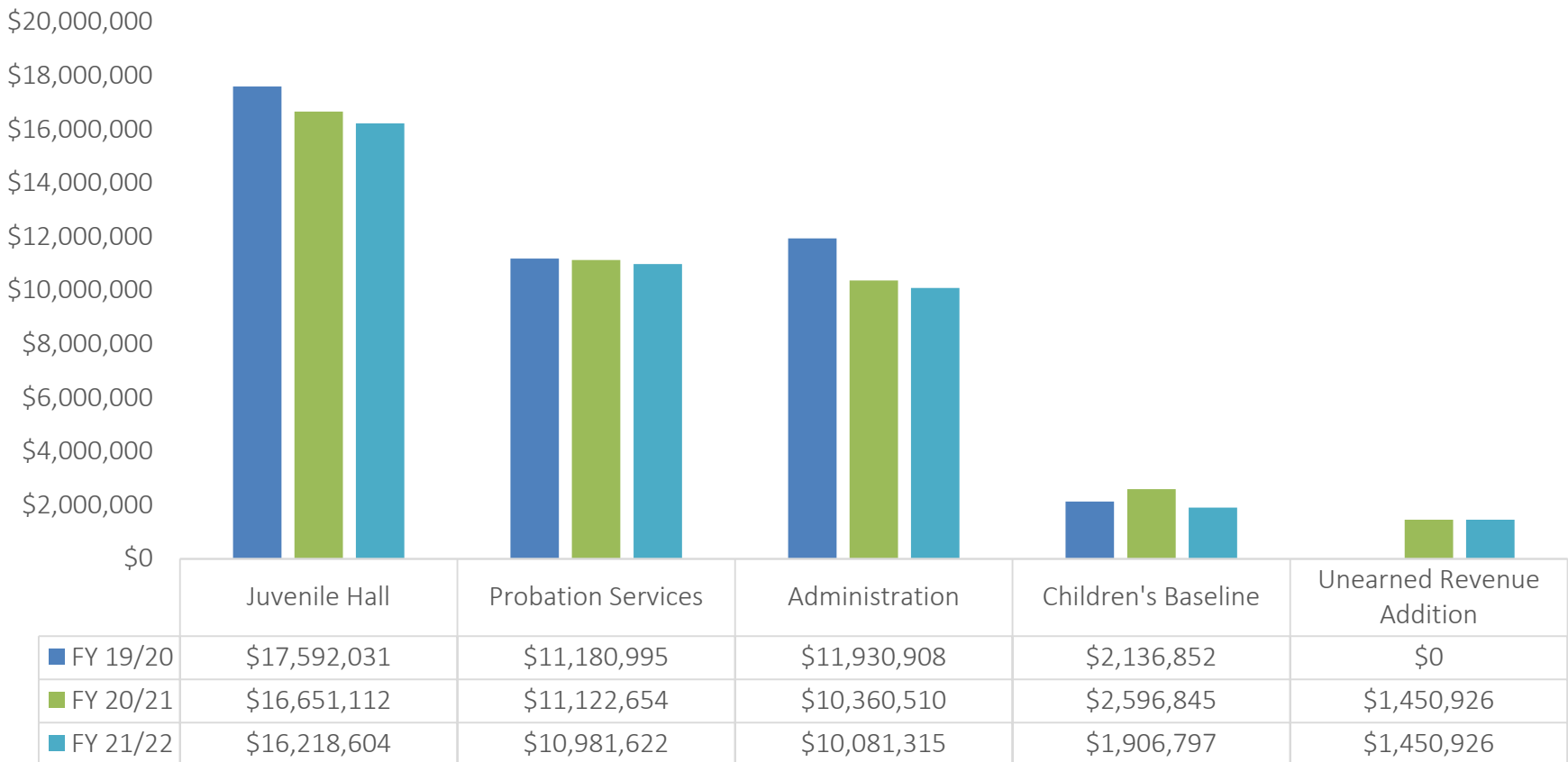

■ FY 19/20 ■ FY 20/21 ■ FY 21/22

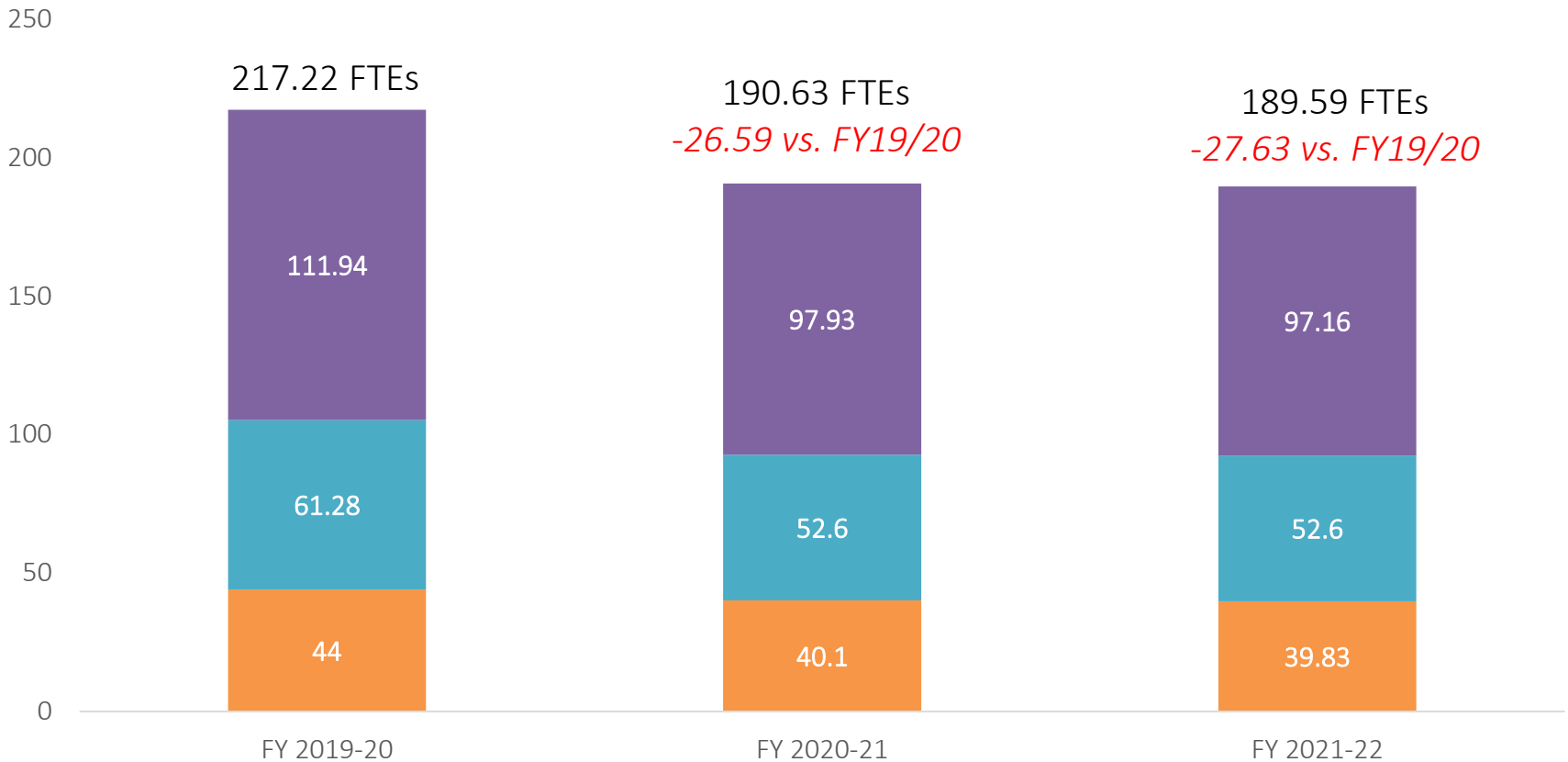

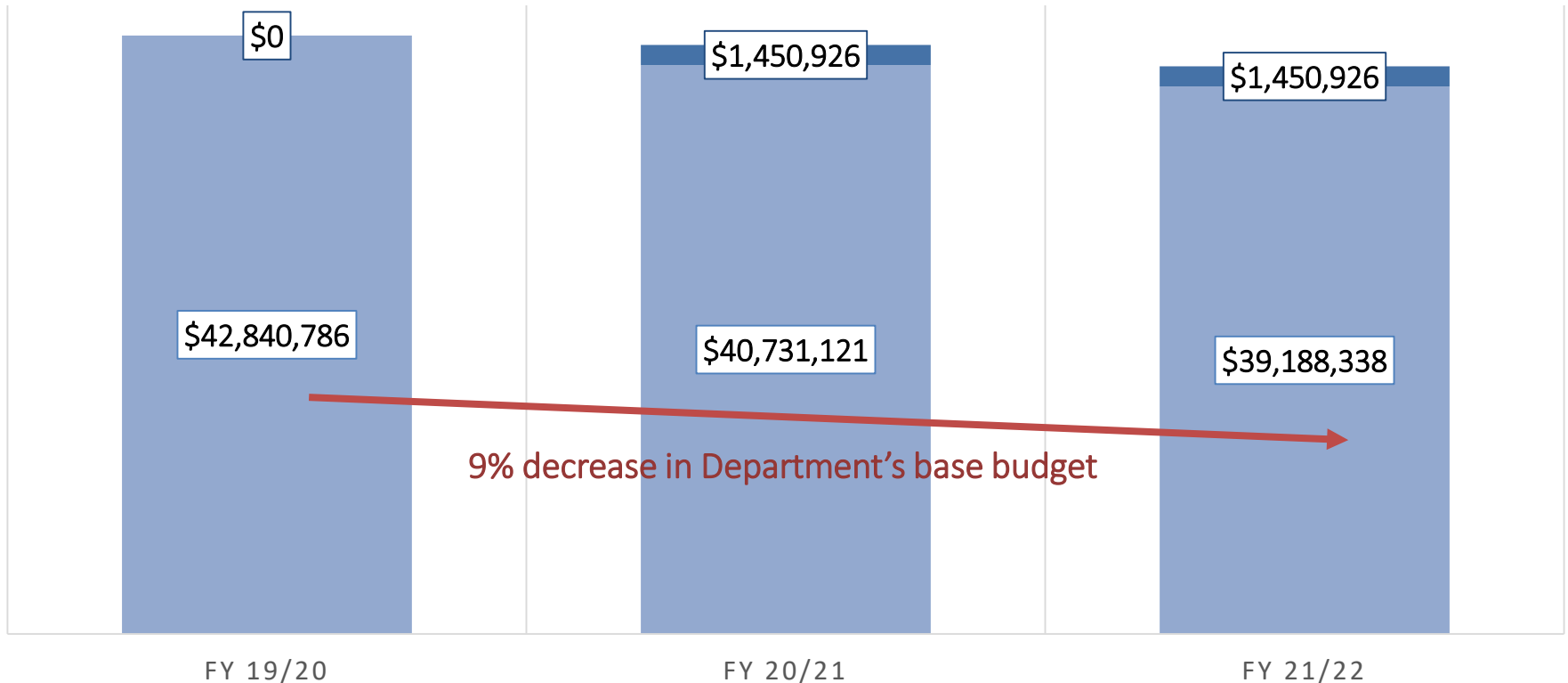
