5 WHEREAS, Less than three years ago, the site of Pac Bell Park
6 contained little more than an asphalt road, concrete blockhouses and
7 an abandoned railroad line; and

8 WHEREAS, For months on end, construction crews worked tirelessly
9 to pound 2,500 100-foot pilings into the ground to form a foundation
10 for the stadium; and

11 WHEREAS, Workers handled over 66,000 yards of structural
12 concrete, over 4,000 tons of steel, and more than 650,000 bricks in
13 building Pac Bell Park; and

14 WHEREAS, Two thousand construction workers contributed over 1
15 million work hours to the building of Pac Bell Park; and

16 WHEREAS, Workers involved in building the Park included
17 carpenters, bricklayers, cement masons, iron workers, electricians,
18 operating engineers, painters, plumbers, sheet metal workers,
19 stonemasons and more; and

20 WHEREAS, The Park is impressive and unique featuring seats with
21 views of the Bay, large dugouts, a Coke bottle, "Rusty" the
22 mechanical ballplayer, and 80 or so concession stands and kiosks; and

23 WHEREAS, The \$319 million project came in on time and on budget;
24 now, therefore, be it
