11 incarcerated women, the Sheriff's Department will offer a program to encourage family literacy,
12 improve skills and use learning as a means of family reunification for incarcerated women and
13 their children while in custody; and,

15 WHEREAS, The grant does not require matching funds; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department proposes to maximize use of available grant
17 funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,
18 therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in
21 the grant budget; and, be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That a grant award notification has been received from the
24 Zellerbach Family Foundation; and, be it


1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City & County of San Francisco will adhere to the


