WHEREAS. The Chinatown Youth Center is the only agency serving high-risk recent Chinese immigrant youth in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, A delay in the release of the funding puts this high-risk Asian youth population at further risk; now, therefore, be it

MOVED. That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby release \$100,000 placed on reserve for the Chinatown Youth Center's Positive Learning and Activities for Youth program.
