

1 [Bicycle Reimbursement and Purchasing]  
2 URGING THE MAYOR TO DIRECT THE DIRECTOR OF HUMAN RESOURCES AS PART OF  
3 FUTURE CONTRACT NEGOTIATIONS TO PROPOSE THAT THE CITY SHOULD PROVIDE  
4 REIMBURSEMENT FOR USE OF PRIVATELY OWNED BICYCLES BY CITY EMPLOYEES  
5 AND OFFICIALS AS PART OF THE EMPLOYEES' BENEFITS AND THAT SUCH  
6 REIMBURSEMENT SHOULD BE CONTINGENT UPON THE USE OF BICYCLE HELMETS  
7 AND URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC TO WORK WITH THE  
8 CITY PURCHASER TO DEVELOP A FEASIBILITY STUDY AND PURCHASING PLAN  
9 REGARDING THE PURCHASE AND MAINTENANCE OF A POOL OF BICYCLES TO BE  
10 USED FOR CITY BUSINESS.

11 WHEREAS, The City wishes to encourage City employees and  
12 officers to use bicycles for travel in connection with city business  
13 where a privately owned or city owned motor vehicle would otherwise  
14 be used; and

15 WHEREAS, The City currently reimburses City employees for the  
16 use of privately owned vehicles, and could adopt similar  
17 reimbursement procedures for the use of privately owned bicycles as  
18 an incentive to city employees for bicycle use; and

19 WHEREAS, The use of bicycle helmets decreases the risk of  
20 injury; and

21 WHEREAS, The City could purchase several bicycles for the price  
22 of one City automobile; and

23 WHEREAS, A City bicycle pool would facilitate increased use of  
24 bicycles by City employees; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Mayor to  
2 direct the Director of Human Resources, as part of future contract




