

1 [Parking Control – Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place]

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3 **Ordinance amending Article 3, Section 32.6.21 of the San Francisco Traffic Code to**
4 **extend the boundary of the existing permit area, remove the official city-owned vehicle**
5 **requirement and to replace references to Polk Street with Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place**
6 **to reflect official name change.**

10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. Article 3 of the San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by amending
12 Section 32.6.21, to read as follows:

13 Sec. 1.

14 **SEC. 32.6.21. PARKING CONTROL, PORTIONS OF ~~POLK STREET~~ DR. CARLTON**
15 **B. GOODLETT PLACE; PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.**

16 No person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or
17 unattended, at the following locations:

19 (a) ~~Polk Street~~ Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, east side, from 32 feet to 224 feet
20 north of Grove Street (192-foot zone, accommodating 16 angled parking stalls);

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22 (b) ~~Polk Street~~ Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, west side, from 26 feet to 208 feet
23 south of McAllister Street (182-foot zone, accommodating nine parking stalls); and

24 (c) ~~Polk Street~~ Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, west side, from 351 feet to 531 feet
25 south of McAllister Street (180-foot zone, accommodating nine parking stalls); and

1 (d) Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, east side, from 184 feet to 208 feet south of McAllister
2 Street (24-foot zone accommodating two angled parking stalls) except ~~official City-owned~~ vehicles
3 displaying a valid permit issued by the Department of Administrative Services authorizing
4 parking in such zones. The permit exceptions under this Section shall not apply when parking
5 prohibition regulations for street-cleaning purposes are in effect. Violation of this Section is an
6 obstruction to the free use of property and a nuisance within the meaning of Division 4, Part
7 III of the Civil Code of California relating to nuisance and the abatement thereof.
