12	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding		
13	Chapter 10G, to read as follows:		
14	CHAPTER 10G		
15	BOARD OF APPEALS SURCHARGE FOR PERMITS AND FEES		
16	Sec. 10G.1 In order to recover the cost to the City and County for the Board of Appeals		
17	permit review functions, at the time a fee for permit application, issuance, or review is collected, a		
18	surcharge in the amount specified shall be charged and collected for the following categories of		
19	permits and fees:		
20	(a) <u>For fees imposed by the Department of City Planning pursuant to San Francisco</u>		
21	Planning Code Sections 353(a), 353(b), 353(d)(3), 353(d)(4), 353((d)(5) or 355 for review of permits		
22	that may be appealed to the Board of Appeals pursuant to Charter Section 4.106, a surcharge of \$6.50;		
23	(b) For permits issued pursuant to San Francisco Building Code Section 110: Tables 1-A,		
24	1-G, Item 3, 1-H, or 1-Q, Item 5 that may be appealed to the Board of Appeals pursuant to Charter		
25	Section 4.106, a surcharge of \$6.50;		

1	(c) For permits issued pursuant to the San Francisco Public Works Code that may be
2	appealed to the Board of Appeals pursuant to Charter Section 4.106, a surcharge of 58 cents (\$0.58);
3	(d) For permits issued pursuant to San Francisco Police Code Section 2.26 that may be
4	appealed to the Board of Appeals pursuant to Charter Section 4.106, a surcharge of \$11.25;
5	(e) For permits issued pursuant to San Francisco Police Code Section 2.26.1 that may be
6	appealed to the Board of Appeals pursuant to Charter Section 4.106, a surcharge of \$7.26
7	SEC. 10-G.2. ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT OF SURCHARGE RATE.
8	(a) Beginning with fiscal year 2004-2005, the Controller shall each year adjust the
9	surcharges set in this Chapter without further action by the Board of Supervisors, to reflect changes in
10	the relevant Consumer Price Index.
11	(b) Not later than January 31 of each year, the Board of Appeals shall submit to the
12	Controller data showing the allocation by department of origin for permits heard by the Board of
13	Appeals during the previous calendar year.
14	(c) No later than April 15th of each year, each department authorized to collect the
15	surcharge pursuant to this Chapter shall submit its current surcharge schedule and the number of
16	appealable permits filed during the prior calendar year to the Controller, who shall apply the price
17	index adjustment to produce a new fee schedule for the following year. In no event may the price index
18	adjustment authorized by this Section cause the surcharge authorized by this Chapter to exceed the
19	department's allocable share of Board of Appeals costs.
20	(d) No later than May 15th of each year, the Controller shall adjust the surcharge to ensure
21	that: (1) each surcharge produces sufficient revenue to support each fee category's allocable share of
22	Board of Appeals costs, and (2) each surcharge does not produce revenue which is projected to
23	materially exceed each fee category's allocable share of Board of Appeals costs. If the Controller
24	determines that the surcharge and applicable price index adjustment will either (1) not adequately
25	cover, or (2) exceed the projected cost of Board of Appeals review subject to the surcharge, the affected

1	department shall file legislation that would adjust the surcharge for the affected department(s) to the appropriate level.
