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3	Resolution authorizing the execution and performance of an Exchange Agreement
4	with the City of Brisbane relating to the replacement of Crystal Springs Pipeline
5	Number 1.
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7	WHEREAS, On November 9, 1999, per Resolution No. 99-0284, the San Francisco
8	Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) approved the award of San Francisco Water
9	Department Contract No. WD-2184, Crystal Springs Pipeline No. 1 Replacement (CSPL
10	No.1), to Mitchell Engineering; and,
11	WHEREAS, Sections of the new alignment for replacement of the CSPL No. 1 are
12	within the public right-of-way and under the jurisdiction of the City of Brisbane; and,
13	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco (CCSF), under the jurisdiction of
14	the SFPUC, owns a 12-inch diameter water pipeline located within the Tunnel Avenue
15	right-of-way in the City of Brisbane, that runs approximately 1250 feet south of the San
16	Francisco-San Mateo County line (the "Tunnel Avenue Pipeline"); and,
17	WHEREAS, Brisbane has offered a 30-foot wide easement (the "Park Easement"),
18	through the Brisbane Community Park valued at \$23,500 in exchange for the Tunnel
19	Avenue Pipeline; and,
20	WHEREAS, The Park Easement will allow a new alignment of CSPL No. 1 to cross
21	from Old County Road to San Francisco Avenue, thereby (i) avoiding construction through
22	residential and commercial areas of Brisbane and saving the CCSF approximately
23	\$168,000, and (ii) eliminating the need for an additional 257 feet of pipe that would
24	otherwise be required; and,
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1	WHEREAS, CCSF's Real Estate Division has determined that the value of the Park
2	Easement to be acquired by CCSF equals or exceeds the value of the Tunnel Avenue
3	Pipeline; and,
4	WHEREAS, The Tunnel Avenue Pipeline is surplus to the water enterprise and the
5	public will not be inconvenienced by the transfer of the Tunnel Avenue Pipeline; and
6	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Water Supply and Treatment Division of the SFPUC
7	considers the transfer of ownership of the Tunnel Avenue Pipeline in exchange for the Park
8	Easement to be in the best interests of the SFPUC; and
9	WHEREAS, The Planning Department's Major Environmental Analysis Section has
10	adopted and issued a Negative Declaration under the California Environmental Quality Act
11	Guidelines, and this Commission has reviewed the Negative Declaration and concurs with
12	its findings; now, therefore, be it
13	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
14	hereby approves the terms and conditions and authorizes the execution, delivery and
15	performance of the Exchange Agreement, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
16	Board of Supervisors, in order to effectuate an exchange of the Tunnel Avenue Pipeline for
17	the Park Easement; and, be it
18	FURTHER RESOLVED, That all necessary actions taken by any City and County of
19	San Francisco official in conformance with the Exchange Agreement are hereby ratified,
20	approved and confirmed by the Board of Supervisors; and, be it
21	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the General Manager of the San Francisco Public
22	Utilities Commission and the Director of Property are hereby authorized to execute the
23	Exchange Agreement, together with the easement deed and any other documents
24	contemplated therein, in order to effectuate the intent of this resolution.
