3	Ordinance for FY 2009-2010, the Controller shall amend the Interim Annual Salary Ordinance					
4	to reflect this position authority.

6	Section 2. Authorization to Accept and Expend Funds.					
7	This Ordinance authorizes the Human Services Agency to accept and expend a grant in the					
8	amount of \$28,141,437 for the operation of a subsidized employment program known as Jobs					
9	NOW. The United States Department of Health and Human Services provides funds to the City					
10	and County of San Francisco, through the California Department of Social Services, to operate					
11	the California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) Program. CalWORKs					
12	funds include local state dollars as well as federal Temporary Aid to Needy Families (TANF)					
13	dollars. With the passage of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), Congress					
14	expanded the kinds of expenses that can be reimbursed with TANF funds. HSA will be able to					
15	claim reimbursement for 80% of expenses associated with subsidized employment programs					
16	and related ancillary services for current and former recipients of CalWORKs aid. Pending					
17	state guidance, HSA may also be authorized to spend TANF funds on a broader population as					
18	well, including non-custodial parents and families earning income less than 200% of the					
19	Federal Poverty Level.
