2 Ordinance, FY 2009-2010. Human Service Agency’s Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
3 (TANF) Emergency Contingency Fund (ECF) as part of the American Recovery and
4 Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA).]

5 **Ordinance amending the Annual Salary Ordinance No. (File No. 090541) for**
6 **FY 2009-2010 to reflect the addition of temporary salaries of \$7,737,578 and authorizing**
7 **the Human Services Agency to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$28,141,437**
8 **from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, TANF Emergency**
9 **Contingency Fund, as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, to**
10 **sponsor the Mayor’s Jobs NOW Program.**

14 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

15 Section 1. **Grant-funded Positions; Amendment to FY 2009-2010 Annual Salary Ordinance.**

16 The hereinafter designated section and item of the Annual Salary Ordinance, FY 2009
17 2010 is hereby amended so that the same shall read as follows:

2 In the event that this ordinance is approved prior to the adoption of the Annual Salary
3 Ordinance for FY 2009-2010, the Controller shall amend the Interim Annual Salary Ordinance
4 to reflect this position authority.

5
6 **Section 2. Authorization to Accept and Expend Funds.**

7 This Ordinance authorizes the Human Services Agency to accept and expend a grant in the
8 amount of \$28,141,437 for the operation of a subsidized employment program known as Jobs
9 NOW. The United States Department of Health and Human Services provides funds to the City
10 and County of San Francisco, through the California Department of Social Services, to operate
11 the California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) Program. CalWORKs
12 funds include local state dollars as well as federal Temporary Aid to Needy Families (TANF)
13 dollars. With the passage of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), Congress
14 expanded the kinds of expenses that can be reimbursed with TANF funds. HSA will be able to
15 claim reimbursement for 80% of expenses associated with subsidized employment programs
16 and related ancillary services for current and former recipients of CalWORKs aid. Pending
17 state guidance, HSA may also be authorized to spend TANF funds on a broader population as
18 well, including non-custodial parents and families earning income less than 200% of the
19 Federal Poverty Level.
