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[Retroactively Accept-Expend Federal Grant]

Resolution authorizing the Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice to retroactively accept and expend supplemental grant funding in the amount of \$10,000 for Federal FY 1999 and a grant amount of \$14,655 for Federal FY 2002 from the U.S. Department of Justice under the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Act to equip law enforcement officers in the Sheriff's Department, Police Department and the Office of the District Attorney with armor vests.

WHEREAS, The Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Act of 1998 (Public Law 105-181) provides money to be administered by the U.S. Department of Justice, to protect the lives of law enforcement officers by helping States, units of local government, and tribal governments to equip their law enforcement officers with armor vests; and

WHEREAS, The Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Act directs the Bureau of Justice Assistance, Department of Justice, to award money on a need basis to purchase vests; and

WHEREAS, In adherence to the Department of Justice requirements that the applicant of each eligible jurisdiction coordinate vests needs among the law enforcement agencies in their jurisdiction that apply; and

WHEREAS, The Federal grant requires a fifty percent local contribution toward (i.e., match of) each jurisdiction's total cost of eligible vest purchases; and

WHEREAS, Because the entire award by the Department of Justice's Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Act funds direct purchases of vests, it is requested that indirect costs be waived; and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff, Police and the District Attorney have budgeted over \$25,515 for the purchase of Bulletproof Vests as matching funds; and

WHEREAS, The act considers as eligible for funding any vests purchased on or after March 1, 1999 regardless of the federal fiscal year of the grant award; and

WHEREAS, Under the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Act, the City and County of San Francisco was awarded a supplemental funding grant of \$10,000 for Federal FY 1999 and \$14,655 for Federal FY 2002 to pay 50% cost of purchasing 106 bulletproof vests; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice to retroactively accept and expend \$ 10,000 for Federal FY 1999 and \$14,655 for Federal FY 2002 from the U.S. Department of Justice under the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Act of 1998.
