

1 [Liquor License, 1749 Union Street]

3 **Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type 20 off-sale beer and wine**
4 **license to 1749 Union Street (District 2), to Lorrie Hoel for Wine's About You, will**
5 **serve the public convenience or necessity of the people of the City and County of**
6 **San Francisco, in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and**
7 **Professions Code, with conditions.**

9 WHEREAS, Lorrie Hoel is seeking issuance of a Type 20 Off-Sale Beer and
10 Wine License for Wine’s About You, located at 1749 Union Street; and,

11 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
12 zoned; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license
14 application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business
16 and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
17 Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the issuance of a Type 20
18 Off-Sale Beer and Wine License, to Lorrie Hoel for Wine’s About You, located at 1749
19 Union Street, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the people of the City
20 and County of San Francisco.

21 Conditions: (1) Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between
22 the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. daily. (2) No noise shall be audible beyond the
23 area under control of the licensee(s) as defined on ABC-257. (3) No person under the
24 age of 21 shall sell or deliver alcoholic beverages. (4) Petitioner shall not make
25 structural changes in the premises interior without prior written approval from the

1 Department. (5) The sales of beer or malt beverages in quantities of 16 oz., 22 oz., 32
2 oz., 40 oz., or similar size containers are prohibited. (6) The petitioner shall utilize
3 electronic surveillance and recording equipment that is able to view all exit and entrance
4 points of the exterior of the premises. This electronic surveillance/recording shall be
5 operational at all times that the premises are open to the public. Said electronic
6 recording shall be maintained for no less than 72 hours and shall be made available to
7 the Department or Police Department upon demand.
