1 [Appointment – Children and Families First Commission]

Motion appointing Mary Hansell, for an indefinite term, to the Children and Families First Commission, residency requirement waived.

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person to serve as a member of the Children and Families First Commission, pursuant to the provisions of the San Francisco Administrative Code, Sections 10.117-122 and 86.1 through 86.5, for the term specified:

Mary Hansell (residency requirement waived), seat 1, succeeding Twila Brown, retired, must be the Director of Public Health or his/her designee, for an indefinite term, and, be it FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Children and Families First Commission has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- Applicant Mary Hansell, appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a
 person with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Children and
 Families First Commission.
- 3. The Children and Families First Commission has attempted to fill the position, for which Mary Hansell was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Mary Hansell is qualified to serve on the Children and Families First Commission.
- 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the

1	specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is
2	willing to serve on Children and Families First Commission at this time; and, be it
3	FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement
4	for Mary Hansell, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be
5	found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to
6	boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of
7	Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
