I myself am old--about to be 79--white, female, a resident of District 2 since 1974, middle class. Unlike many San Francisco districts, these characteristics are typical of District 2. I look like my neighbors. I'm married, also a characteristic of many people living in this district, and straight. I have two adult children, but only one lives in San Francisco, and then only part of the time. This is true of many older adults living in San Francisco. I am not disabled (yet.) My concerns, like many of my friends and neighbors, are of how I (and my husband) can age at home in a late Victorian with many stairs. I'm interested in services which can help me do this, and DAAS has many such services.

**Business and/or professional experience:**

I received my Ph.D. in Sociology/Gerontology from Columbia University in 1970. Starting in 1962, I worked on studies of aging in community at the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF), and continued to work in gerontology, studying On Lok/Lifeways model of care, day care for the elderly, hospital discharge planning/transitional care, adult development, and mental health and aging. Most of this work was at UCSF. I published, and served on professional boards and committees in aging. I retired about 1997.


**Civic Activities:**

I serve on the Transitions Committee from Hospital to Home of DAAS. I have been on the Board of the Community Living Campaign for the last 6 years, serving as President twice, and active in other aging organizations, such as the Public Authority and PECC, since before retirement. I've also served on the Board of San Francisco Suicide Prevention. My husband and I are founding members of San Francisco Village, where we have been interested in transitions from hospital to home as well, and in promoting the growth of networks of mutual support among Village members.

**Authority:**

Administrative Code, Section 5.54 (Ordinance Nos. 500-80, and 248-85; Res. No. 499-03) and Bylaws of the Advisory Council

**Board Qualifications:**

The Advisory Council is not to exceed 22 members (voting members), 11 of whom shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors and 11 members appointed by the Commission on the Aging. More than 50% of each group of 11 members shall be persons who are 60 years of age or older. The Council shall be representative of the geographic and ethnic populations of the City and County of San Francisco by districts determined by the Commission. The Council shall include service providers, older persons with the greatest socio and economic need, consumers, and others specified by federal regulation.

The Advisory Council members shall be appointed to serve two-year terms. When vacancies occur due to resignation or other causes, they shall be filled by the appointment of a person to fill the unexpired portion of the term by the Commission or corresponding Supervisor.

The Advisory Council shall advise the Commission on the Aging on all matters relating to the development and administration of its area plan and the operations conducted thereunder, including needs assessment, priorities, programs, and budgets, and such other matters relating to the well-being of all senior citizens 60 years of age and older within the scope and spirit of Federal, State and local regulations, laws and ordinances. The Advisory Council member shall be responsible for representing the needs and concerns of all senior citizens in the City and County of San Francisco, duties of which are outlined in the Bylaws.
