Resolution authorizing Hinderliter, De Llamas and Associates to examine sales or transaction and use tax records of the State Board of Equalization on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco pursuant to California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 7056.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has entered into a contract with the firm of Hinderliter, de Llamas and Associates to perform audit and consulting services; and,

WHEREAS, Section 7056 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code allows the governing body of a city and county by resolution to authorize persons other than officers and employees to examine confidential sales or transaction and use tax records of the State Board of Equalization on behalf of the City and County, subject to certain conditions; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco certifies that Hinderliter, de Llamas and Associates: (1) has an existing contract with the City and County to examine those sales or transaction and use tax records; (2) is required by that contract to disclose information contained in, or derived from, those sales or transaction and use tax records only to an officer or employee of the City and County who is authorized under Section 7056 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code to examine the information; (3) is prohibited by that contract from performing consulting services for a retailer during the term of that contract; and, (4) is prohibited by that contract from retaining the information contained in, or derived from, those sales or transaction and use tax records after the contract has expires; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the firm of Hinderliter, de Llamas and Associates is authorized to examine sales or transaction and use tax records of the State Board of Equalization on behalf of the City and County; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That information obtained by examination of said State Board of Equalization records shall be used only for purposes related to the collection of City and County sales or transaction and use taxes, and other governmental functions of the City and County of San Francisco; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall supersede Resolution No. 269-94; and be it
