13	Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference		
14	herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning Department in its letter		
15	dated March 23, 2001, which stated that the actions contemplated herein are consistent with		
16	the General Plan and Eight Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of such		
17	letter is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No		
18	Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works' Order No. 172,912, a		
19	copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No, Board of

6	relocation, modification, or both of facilities in the affected sidewalk and street areas. Any		
7	necessary relocation, modification, or both of such facilities shall be at no cost to the City and		
8	County of San Francisco.
