

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Preterm Birth Initiative Project - \$213,369]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**  
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$213,369 from The Regents of the University of**  
5 **California, San Francisco to participate in a program entitled “Preterm Birth Initiative**  
6 **Project” for the period of July 1, 2014, through May 31, 2015.**

8 WHEREAS, The Regents of the University of California, San Francisco is the recipient  
9 of a grant award from Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation supporting the Preterm Birth  
10 Initiative Project grant; and

11 WHEREAS, With a portion of these funds, The Regents of the University of California,  
12 San Francisco has subcontracted with Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of  
13 \$213,369 for the period of July 1, 2014, through May 31, 2015; and

14 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, The Regents of the University  
15 of California, San Francisco requires the City to enter into an agreement (Agreement), a copy  
16 of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 150411; which is  
17 hereby declared to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

18 WHEREAS, The purpose of this project is to develop the local implementation strategy  
19 that includes identifying the bundle of intervention to deliver care across the life course for  
20 women and babies; and

21 WHEREAS, An Annual Salary Ordinance amendment is not required as the grant  
22 partially reimburses DPH for three existing positions, one Senior Physician Specialist (Job  
23 Class No. 2232) at .075 FTE, one Senior Physician Specialist (Job Class No. 2232) at .15  
24 FTE, and one Health Program Coordinator III (Job Class No. 2593) at .75 FTE for the period  
25 of July 1, 2014, through May 31, 2015; and

1           WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not  
2 receive notification of the award until December 24, 2014, for a project start date of July 1,  
3 2014; and

4           WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of  
5 \$19,937; now, therefore, be it

6           RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant  
7 in the amount of \$213,369 from The Regents of the University of California, San Francisco;  
8 and, be it

9           FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
10 expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

11           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
12 Agreement on behalf of the City.
