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3	Resolution authorizing the Municipal Transportation Agency to accept and expend		
4	\$23,305,667 Federal Formula Section 5309 Fixed Guideway capital projects and		
5	activities, excluding administrative overhead costs.		
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7	WHEREAS, The Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make monies available		
8	under the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA 21) for mass transportation		
9	projects; and		
10	WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency (MTA) of the City and County of San		
11	Francisco, is an eligible claimant for flexible capital or operating assistance projects under		
12	Section 5309-Fixed Guideway of TEA 21; and		
13	WHEREAS, The grant contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations		
14	upon the applicant, including providing the local share of project costs; and		
15	WHEREAS, The local share of project costs will be funded through a variety of		
16	sources, which may include San Francisco Municipal Railway fare revenue, San Francisco		
17	Municipal Railway Improvement Corporation funds, regional bridge toll net revenues and/or		
18	sales taxes administered by the San Francisco County Transportation Authority; and		
19	WHEREAS, The U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) requires that in connection		
20	with the filing of an application for federal assistance, the applicant give an assurance that it		
21	will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. Department of		
22	Transportation requirements implementing that Act; and		
23	WHEREAS, It is the goal of the applicant that disadvantaged business enterprises		
24	(DBEs) be utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and that		
25	definitive procedures be established and administered, consistent with federal law, to ensure		

1 that DBEs are utilized to the fullest extent possible and have the maximum possible

2 opportunity to compete for contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant and other

3 services; and

WHEREAS, Section 5309 Fixed Guideway is a formula-apportioned source of funds
that may be used to build new fixed guideway systems or modernize and enhance existing
fixed guideway systems, including repairing and purchasing rolling stock to operate as part of
the fixed guideway system; and

8 WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission has prepared a regional
9 program of projects that are funded through Section 5309; and

WHEREAS, The MTA's projects that are included in the regional program are high
 priority Municipal Railway capital improvements listed in MTA's current Short Range Transit
 Plan and in the Regional Transportation Plan and include trolley coach procurement, cable
 car infrastructure rehabilitation, rail replacement, overhead lines reconstruction, historic
 streetcar rehabilitation, wayside fare collection equipment procurement, and the Metro East
 Light Rail Facility; and
 WHEREAS, The Director of Transportation of the MTA (or his designee) must execute

agreements to complete transfer of the funds; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, the MTA is

authorized to accept and expend \$23,305,667 in federal Section 5309 Fixed Guideway

- Trolley Coach Procurement
- Cable Car Infrastructure Rehabilitation
- 23 Cable Car Vehicle Renovation
- Overhead Lines Reconstruction
- Historic Rail Car Rehabilitation
