15	herein are consistent with the General Plan and Eight Priority Policies of Planning Code

18	Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works' Order No. 173,197, a		
19	copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. , Board of		
20	Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks," a copy of		
21	which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General Ordinances, in effect May		
22	11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:		
23	Section 1553. The width of sidewalks on portions of Howard and Minna Streets between 4th and 5th		
24	Streets shall be modified as shown on Department of Public Works drawings Q-20-542 and Q-20-543,
