WHEREAS, On December 2, 2003, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors transmitted a copy of the proposed legislation to the Planning Commission for public hearing pursuant to Planning Code Section 302(b); and,

WHEREAS, Planning Code Section 306.4(d)(3) provides that the Planning Commission must render its decision on the proposed legislation within 90 days from the date of referral and that failure to act within the prescribed time shall constitute disapproval; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has requested a 15-day extension of time within which to hold a public hearing before the Planning Commission on the proposed legislation; and

WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant the Planning Commission an additional 15 days within which to render its decision; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That the Board hereby extends the prescribed period of time within which the Planning Commission may review and render its decision on the proposed legislation to and including March 15, 2004.
