3 **Ordinance adding Section 8.36-2 to the San Francisco Administrative Code to create**
4 **fee for investigating the sealing of juvenile court records and for the sealing of such**
5 **records, and making environmental findings.**

10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in
12 this ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California
13 Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.) Said determination is on on file with the Clerk
14 of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____ and is incorporated herein by reference.

15 Section 2. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding
16 Section 8.36-2, to read as follows:

17 ***Sec. 8.36-2. Juvenile Probation Department – Juvenile Record Sealing Fee***

- 18 (a) *The Juvenile Probation Department is hereby authorized to charge a fee to defray the*
19 *actual costs of any investigation related to sealing juvenile court records or sealing such*
20 *records, pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code Section 903.3. The fee may not*
21 *exceed the amount set forth in Section 903.3, which is set at \$120 for the year 2004.*
- 22 (b) *The Juvenile Probation Department may not refuse to investigate, or, if ordered by the*
23 *court, seal the records based on an inability to pay.*
- 24 (c) *All fees received by the Juvenile Probation Department in payment for investigating the*

1 *sealing of records or the sealing of records shall be deposited in the general fund and shall be*
2 *used by the Department in providing such services.*
