OAA History [Renewal Focus]

- January 2011: Ocean Avenue Association (OAA) commences services.
- January 2021: OAA Strategic Plan Finalized (Recommended and funded by OEWD)
 - Designed to provide a roadmap to fix systemic and structural issues in preparation for 2025 renewal | Though this plan spurred some corrective action from OAA, progress was slow.
- **June 2021 2022:** Based on this slow progress and compliance concerns (and in consultation with Supervisor Melgar) OEWD requested the Office of the Controller audit the organization in FY 22–23.
- **June 2023:** Report released finding Controller's Office produced 19 recommendations for OEWD to ensure OAA improved its control environment.
- **July 2024:** Per report-out from OEWD, Controller's Office confirmed close-out of 19 recommendations.
- **June 2024 Current:** Ongoing outreach throughout the corridor around renewal including survey deployment, OAA-hosted open houses, merchant mixers and door-to-door information sharing.



Renewal Process

- 30% threshold reached in **March 2025**
- Resolution of Intention submitted and goes through legislative process [authorizes the special balloting procedure] [Current Phase]
- Ballots go out to ratepayers [May 23, 2025]
- Special ballot procedure ends [July 8, 2025]
- Services commence [1st Quarter of 2026]
