WHEREAS, The Emergency Communications Department's mission is to field emergency 911 calls in the City and County and dispatch the appropriate police, fire/EMS or other Emergency Services resources; and,

WHEREAS, The Emergency Communications Department's dispatchers receive and process about 1.6 million phone calls per year, making it one of the busiest 911/OES centers in the country; and,

WHEREAS, The Emergency Communications Department's Consolidated Emergency Communications Center is a model for the country, and is visited by many local cities, counties, states and foreign countries each year; and,

WHEREAS, The Emergency Communications Department is producing its first Annual Report with a goal of summarizing the Department's services and programs, highlighting achievements of the prior year that the Department wishes to include and presented in terms and format accessible to the average citizen; and,
