2	Resolution honoring Margaret Brodkin as the "Mother of the Children's Fund" on the
3	occasion of the 20 th Anniversary of the Children's Fund, in the City and County of San Francisco.
4	WHEREAS, C ity government recognizes the special responsibility it has to support the
5 6	healthy development of children and youth; and
7	WHEREAS, Coleman Advocates has been the leading voice in San Francisco calling
8	for local, city investments in high quality services to children, young people and families; and,
9	WHEREAS, Before 1991, San Francisco children had no protections from budget cuts
10	and low income children went without basic health and support services; and,
11 12	WHEREAS, Margaret Brodkin, in her role as the Executive Director of Coleman
13	Advocates for Children & Youth, had the vision in 1991 to create a dedicated source of city
14	funding for the city's youth; and,
15	WHEREAS, Margaret Brodkin led Coleman Advocates' campaign to put "Proposition J
16	- the Children's Amendment" on the city ballot by petition, with 50,000 signatures from
17	everyday San Franciscans but almost no support from the city's elected leaders; and,
18	WHEREAS, Proposition J, passed by the voters in 1991, was renewed by 75 percent
19 20	of the voters in 2000, and is now widely supported by community and city leaders; and,
21	WHEREAS, The Children's Fund, now housed at the Department of Children, Youth
22	and their Families, has become a core part of city's safety net serving hundreds of thousands
23	of children, and,
24	WHEREAS. Margaret Brodkin dedicated more than twenty years as a tireless voice for

the idea that the needs of poor children should be among the city's top priorities, and that

1	community need, not political connections, should determine how the city allocates its
2	resources; now, therefore, be it
3	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
4	in recognition of her courage and vision, on the occasion of the 20 th Anniversary of the
5	Children's Fund, honors Margaret Brodkin as the "Mother of the Children's Fund."
