3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Recreation and Park Department to**
4 **retroactively accept and expend an in-kind gift valued at \$96,000 from America Scores**
5 **Bay Area to support operating costs associated with presenting World Cup Live 2010**
6 **in Civic Center Plaza.**

8 WHEREAS, Since 2001, America Scores Bay Area, a non-profit organization, has
9 worked to empower students in urban communities using soccer, writing, creative expression,
10 and service-learning; and

11 WHEREAS, The World Cup soccer tournament is the biggest sporting event in the
12 world, drawing international audiences in the tens of billions; and,

13 WHEREAS, RPD partnered with America Scores Bay Area to present 17 of the 2010
14 FIFA World Cup games, broadcast live at Civic Center Plaza; and,

15 WHEREAS, These events brought tens of thousands of people of all ages together to
16 celebrate the world's game as well as San Francisco's diversity and healthy, active lifestyles
17 in the shadow of City Hall; and,

18 WHEREAS, As co-presenter, America Scores Bay Area agreed to process and
19 administer the sponsorship funds awarded to produce this event; and,


20 WHEREAS, Sponsorship funds awarded to produce World Cup Live 2010 at Civic
21 Center Plaza included gifts from the San Francisco 49ers (\$50,000), Verizon (\$15,000), Visa
22 (\$10,000), Ron Conway and Family (\$10,000), SF Fire Fighters-Local 798 (\$5,000), The
23 Dutch Consulate (\$5,000), and FC Gold Pride (\$1,000); and,

1 WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission recommends that the San
2 Francisco Board of Supervisors retroactively accept and expend the in-kind gift, valued at
3 \$96,000; and,

4 WHEREAS, The City recognizes the generosity of America Scores Bay Area with
5 sincere appreciation; now, therefore, be it


6 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the Gift and authorizes the





To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to confirm that America SCORES Bay Area (SCORES) acted as the fiscal sponsor for the 2010 World Cup Viewing Events at Civic Center Plaza. SCORES formed a partnership with SF Recreation and Parks Department to present live viewings of the World Cup Soccer Games at Civic Center Plaza. As part of our partnership, SCORES agreed to accept donations designated for these free events on behalf, and in turn, SCORES paid for related expenses associated with presenting the games.

The events brought together thousands of San Francisco residents. It was a celebration of the "beautiful game" and our community and all of its diversity. In the end, the gatherings gave a chance for families from all corners of the city to come together and celebrate their national heritages and countries of origin.

SCORES collected \$96,000 in sponsorships for these events. Gifts came from:

- San Francisco 49ers (\$50,000)
- Verizon (\$15,000)
- Visa (\$10,000)
- Ron Conway and Family (\$10,000)
- SF Fire Fighters-Local 798 (\$5,000)
- The Dutch Consulate (\$5,000)
- FC Gold Pride (\$1,000).

SCORES paid out over this amount mostly for the screen rentals, audio services, and security services. In addition, SCORES also contributed hundreds of hours of staff time to provide for free activities like soccer clinics and face painting and to help with clean up.
