

1 [Changing the official sidewalk width – Folsom Street]

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3 **Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1061 entitled “Regulating the Width of**
4 **Sidewalks” by adding thereto Section 1573 to change the official sidewalk**
5 **width on the northerly side of Folsom Street easterly of 8th Street; making**
6 **findings pursuant to the General Plan and Planning Code Section 101.1;**
7 **and requiring relocation, modification, or both of facilities affected by the**
8 **sidewalk width change.**

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates
14 by reference herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning
15 Department in its letter dated August 4, 2006, which stated that this project is in
16 conformity with the San Francisco General Plan and the priority policies of
17 Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of said letter is in the Clerk of the Board of
18 Supervisors File No. _____ and is incorporated herein by reference.

19 Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works’ Order No.
20 176,702, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No.
21 _____, Board of Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled “Regulating the
22 Width of Sidewalks,” a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors
23 Book of General Ordinances, in effect May 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding
24 thereto a new section to read as follows:

25 Section 1573. The official sidewalk width on the northerly side of Folsom
Street shall be as shown on Department of Public Works drawing Q-20-615.

3 Section 3. Hauser Architects, as is necessary as a result of this
4 Ordinance, shall make arrangements with public utility companies and City
5 Departments for the relocation, modification, or both of existing utility facilities in
6 the affected sidewalk and street areas.
