RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, pursuant to applicable provisions of the California Vehicle Code, hereby establishes stop signs at the intersection of Buchanan and Chestnut Streets, northeast, southeast, and southwest corners, stopping all approaches.
