Re: Minimum Compensation Ordinance and the Mayor's FY 2026-27 and FY 2027-28 Proposed Budget

Madam Clerk,

Pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code, SEC 12P.3, the minimum compensation for nonprofit corporations will be \$23.50 as of July 1, 2026. Pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code, SEC 12P.3, the minimum compensation for public entities will be \$25.00 by September 2026, eventually reaching \$25.50 by January 1, 2027.

This letter provides notice to the Board of Supervisors that the Mayor's proposed budget for FY 2026-2027 and FY 2027-2028 contains funding to support these minimum compensation wage levels for nonprofit corporations and public entities.
