5 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle
6 Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the
7 movement of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

8 **NO LEFT TURN - ESTABLISH**

9 Eastbound Plymouth Avenue onto northbound Plymouth Avenue.

10 **RIGHT LANE MUST TURN RIGHT - RESCIND**

11 Polk Street, west side, between McAllister and Redwood Streets.

13 Categorically exempt from Environmental
14 Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and
15 parking regulations where such changes do not
16 establish a higher speed limit or result in more
17 than a negligible increase in the use of the
18 street.




