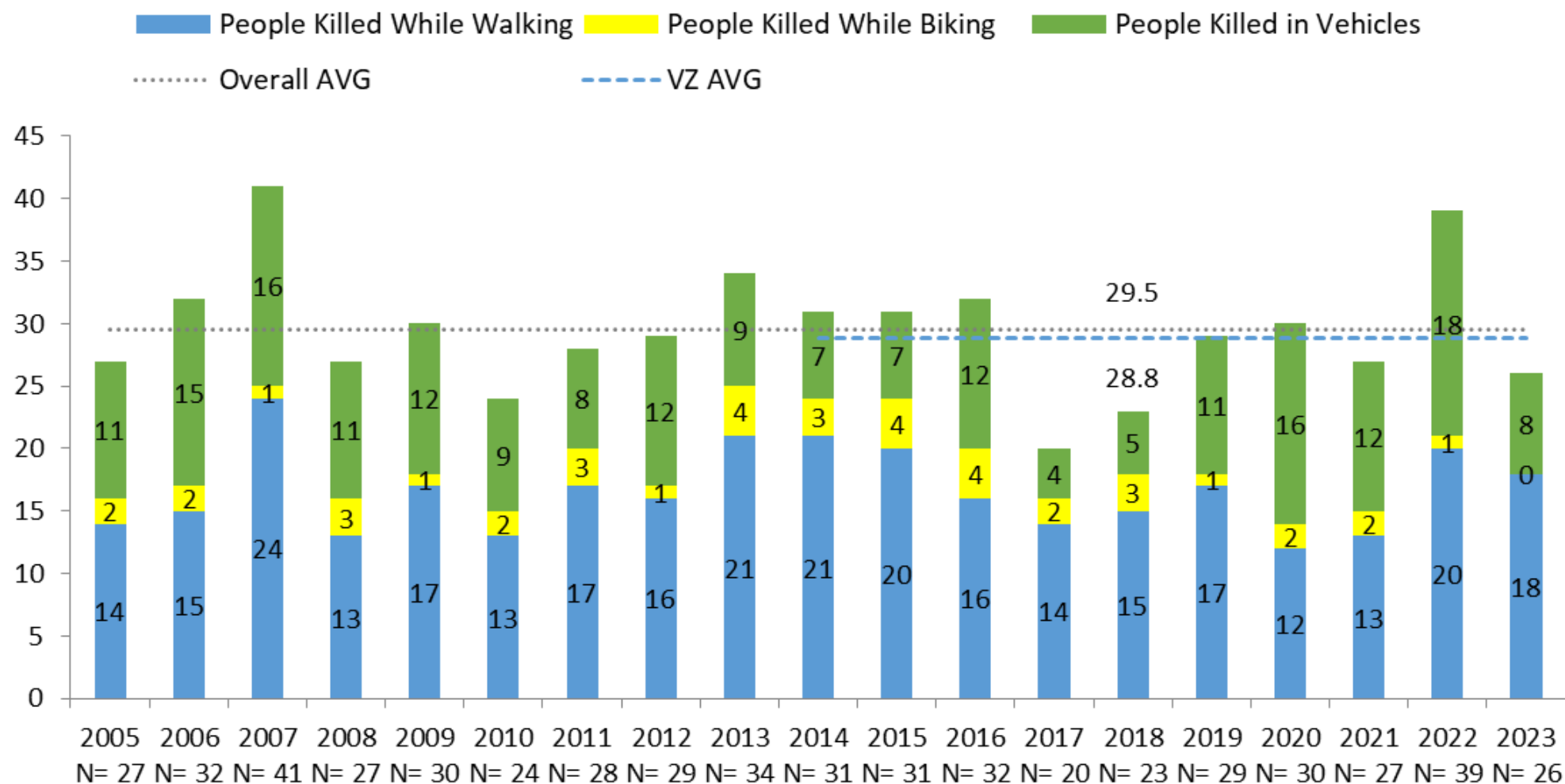

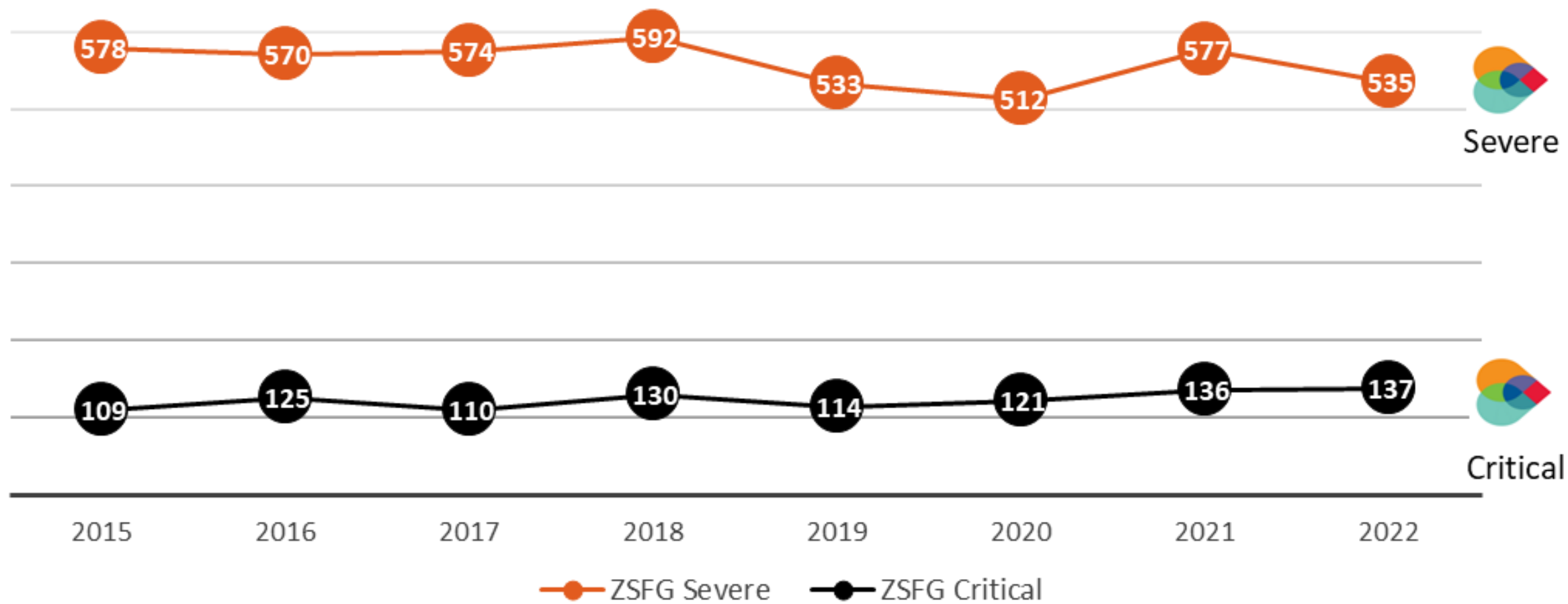

San Francisco Traffic Deaths, 2005-2023

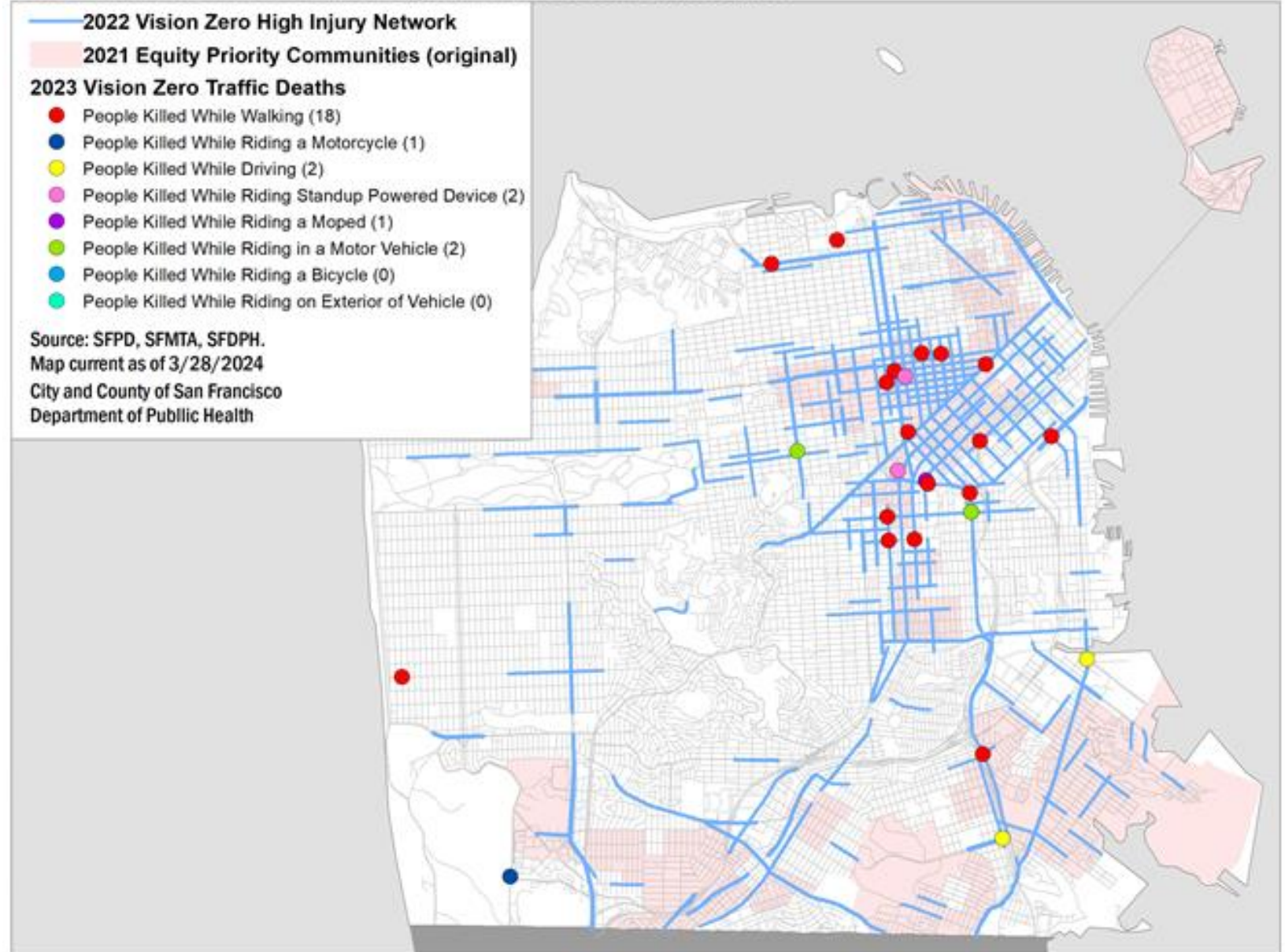

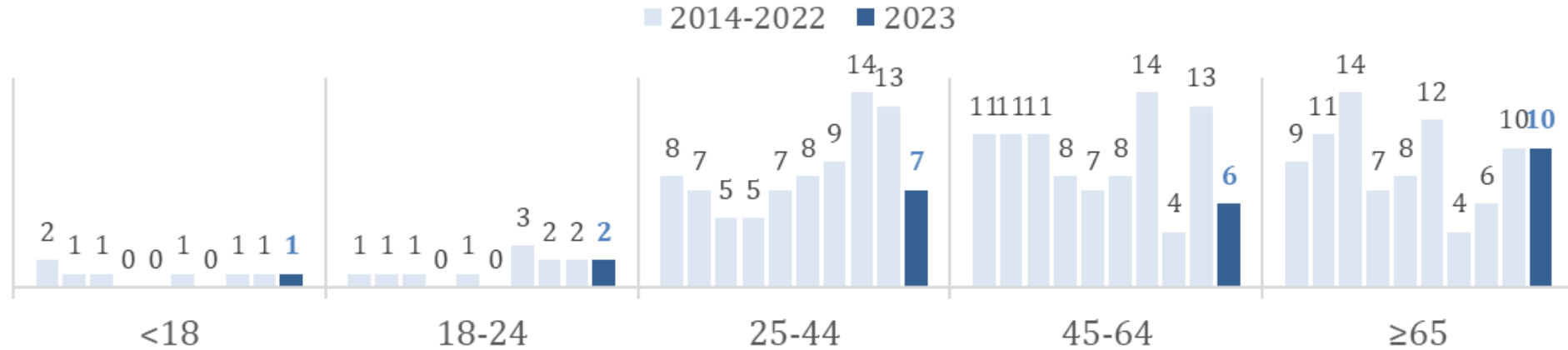
THE VISION ZERO HIGH INJURY NETWORK CAPTURES THE MAJORITY OF FATAL CRASHES ACROSS OUR CITY

2023 Vision Zero Traffic Fatalities by Travel Mode: San Francisco, CA

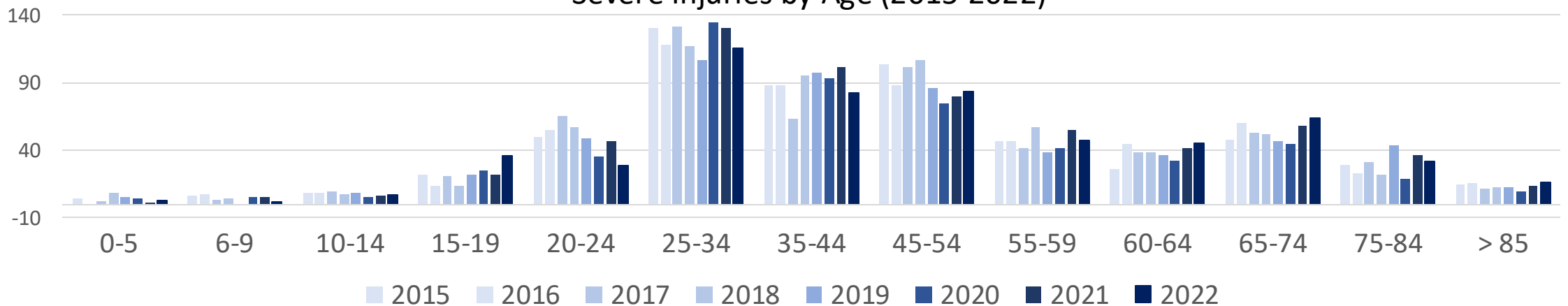

Age Composition of 2023 Traffic Fatalities from 2014 to 2023

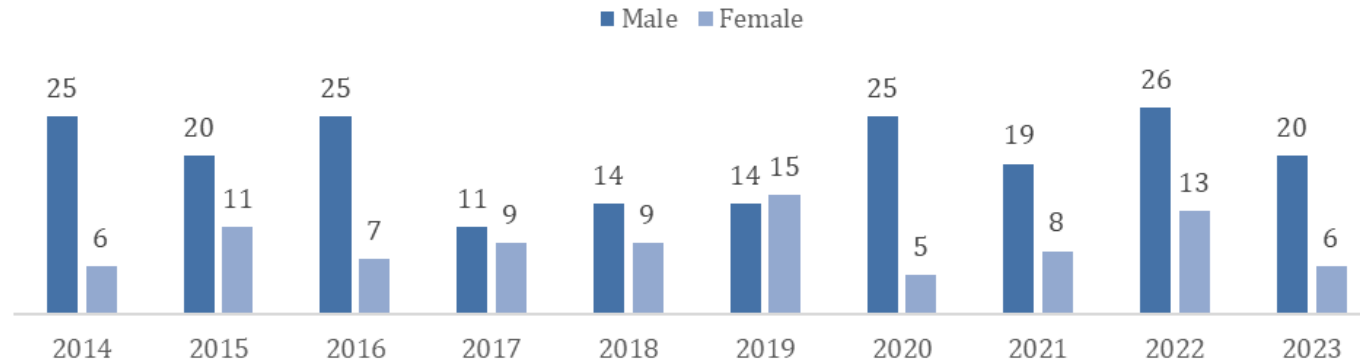


Severe Injuries by Age (2015-2022)

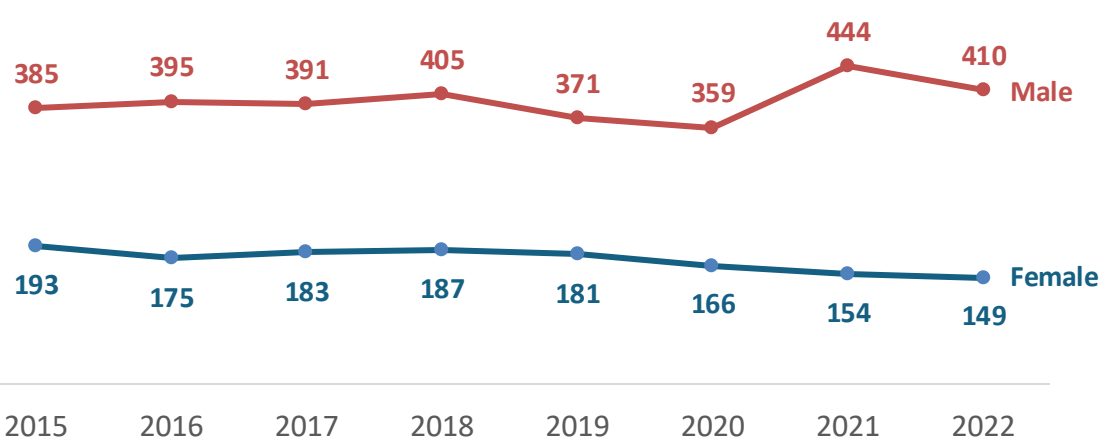

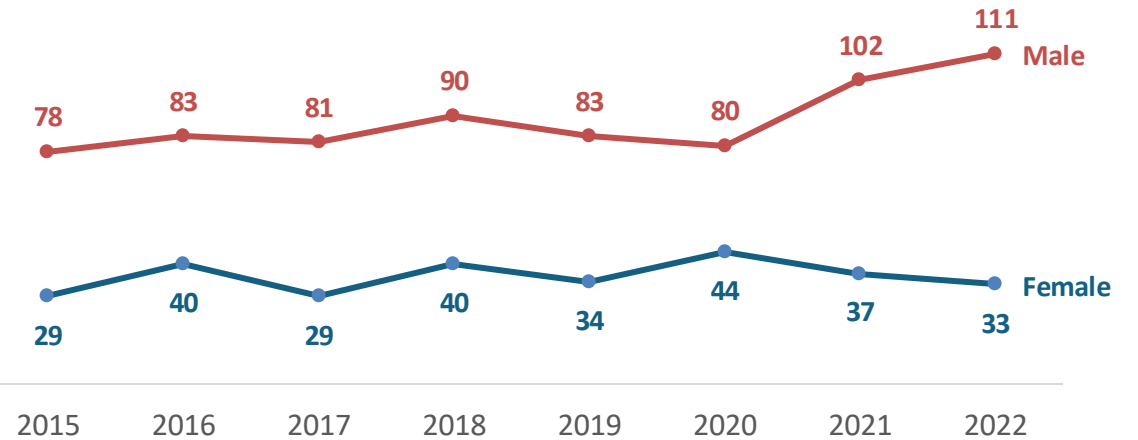
Fatalities by Sex (2014-2023)



Severe Injuries by Sex/Gender (2015-2022)



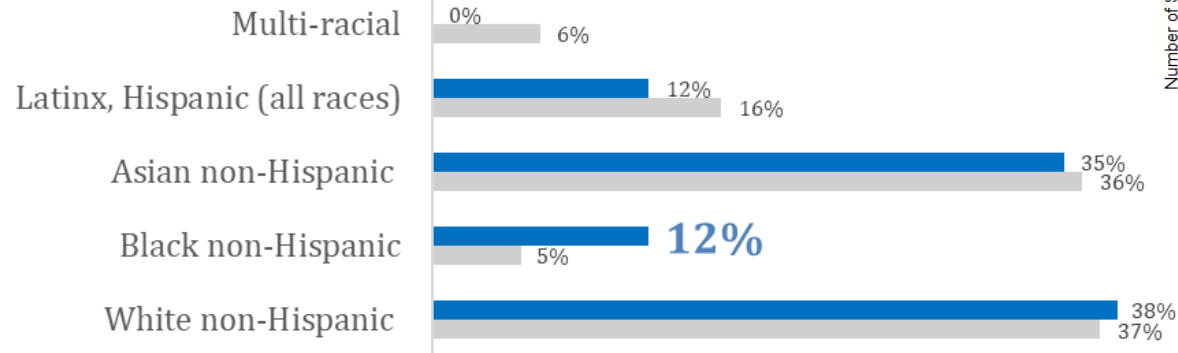
Critical Injuries by Sex/Gender (2015-2022)



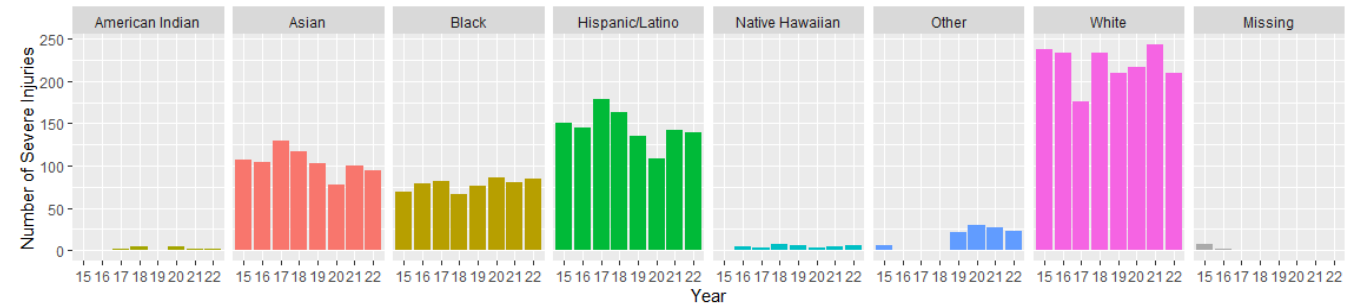
DEMOGRAPHICS – RACE/ETHNICITY

Race/Ethnicity of 2023 Traffic Fatalities (N=26)

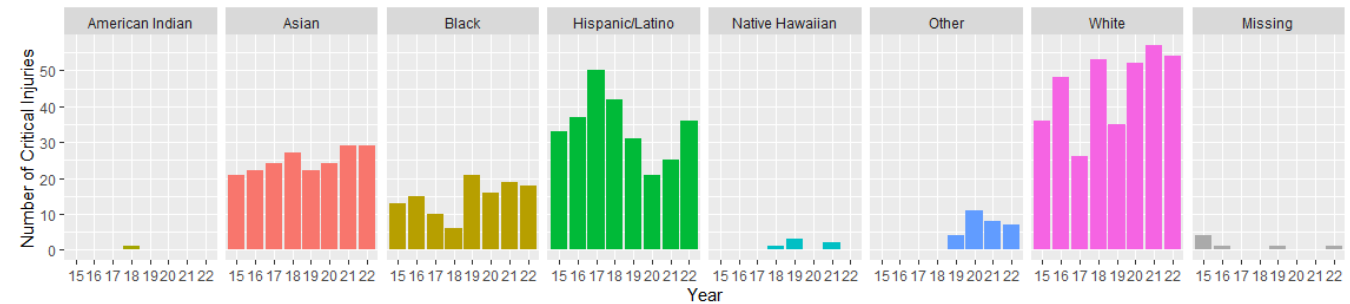
■ % fatalities ■ % of SF population
