Describing and setting forth a proposal to the voters at an election to be held on June 7, 2016, to amend the Charter of the City and County of San Francisco to require the Mayor to fill a supervisorial vacancy within 28 days.

[Charter Amendment - Filling Supervisorial Vacancies Within 28 Days]

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby submits to the qualified voters of the City and County, at an election to be held on June 7, 2016, a proposal to amend the Charter of the City and County by revising Section 13.101.5, to read as follows:

Asterisks (* * * *) indicate the omission of unchanged Charter subsections.

SEC. 13.101.5. VACANCIES.

- (a) If the office of Assessor-Recorder, City Attorney, District Attorney, Public Defender, Sheriff, Treasurer, or Member of the Board of Supervisors, Board of Education or Governing Board of the Community College District becomes vacant because of death, resignation, recall, permanent disability, or the inability of the respective officer to otherwise carry out the responsibilities of the office, the Mayor shall appoint an individual qualified to fill the vacancy under this Charter and state laws. *The Mayor shall appoint an individual to fill a vacancy on the Board of Supervisors within 28 days of the date of the vacancy.*
- (b) If the Office of Mayor becomes vacant because of death, resignation, recall, permanent disability or the inability to carry out the responsibilities of the office, the President of the Board of Supervisors shall become Acting Mayor and shall serve until a successor is appointed by the Board of Supervisors.

- (c) Any person filling a vacancy pursuant to subsection (a) or (b) of this Section shall serve until a successor is selected at the next election occurring not less than 120 days after the vacancy, at which time an election shall be held to fill the unexpired term, provided that (1) if an election for the vacated office is scheduled to occur less than one year after the vacancy, the appointee shall serve until a successor is selected at that election or (2) if an election for any seat on the same board as the vacated seat is scheduled to occur less than one year but at least 120 days after the vacancy, the appointee shall serve until a successor is selected at that election to fill the unexpired term.
- (d) If no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast at an election to fill a vacated office, the two candidates receiving the most votes shall qualify to have their names placed on the ballot for a municipal runoff election at the next regular or otherwise scheduled election occurring not less than five weeks later. If an instant runoff election process is enacted for the offices enumerated in this Section, that process shall apply to any election required by this Section.

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

(Second Draft – Amended in Committee, 1/28/16)

[Charter Amendment - Filling Supervisorial Vacancies Within 28 Days]

Describing and setting forth a proposal to the voters at an election to be held on June 7, 2016, to amend the Charter of the City and County of San Francisco to require the Mayor to fill a supervisorial vacancy within 28 days.

Existing Law

When a seat on the Board of Supervisors becomes vacant because of the death, resignation, recall, permanent disability, or the inability of the officer to otherwise carry out the responsibilities of the office, the Mayor has the authority to appoint a successor to fill the vacancy until an election is held. The Charter does not impose any deadline for the Mayor's vacancy appointments.

Amendments to Current Law

The Mayor would be required to make an appointment to fill a vacancy on the Board of Supervisors within 28 days of the date of the vacancy.

Background Information

This legislative digest reflects amendments made by the Rules Committee on January 28, 2016. On that day, the Committee duplicated the file and amended the duplicate file to remove almost all of the proposed changes to the vacancy appointment and election process. The proposal now solely requires the Mayor to make vacancy appointments for the Board of Supervisors within 28 days of the date of the vacancy.
