COMMENDING REVEREND ZACHARY SHORE OF THE MOST HOLY REDEEMER
CATHOLIC CHURCH FOR HIS COURAGE IN EXPRESSING OPPOSITION TO
ARCHDIOCESE OF SAN FRANCISCO'S FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION TO THE KNIGHT
INITIATIVE CAMPAIGN.

WHEREAS, Senator William Knight (R-Palmdale) has introduced a California ballot measure which would circumscribe the legal definition of marriage to exclude same sex marriages; and

WHEREAS, A consortium of Archdioceses throughout California have contributed up \$310,000 in support of the anti-gay Knight initiative; and

WHEREAS, The Archdiocese of San Francisco, which enjoys tax exempt status, contributed over \$31,000 to the politically partisan and homophobic Knight Initiative; and

WHEREAS, The Knight Initiative is hurtful and harmful to the lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender communities throughout California and will further divide families; and

WHEREAS, The proposed initiative also legalizes discrimination against same sex couples who desire to commit to a long term relationship and want the same legal protection and rights that heterosexual couples are entitled to; and

WHEREAS, The Knight Initiative will contribute to intolerance, divisiveness and hate, even contributing to hate crimes and hate violence targeting Queer communities throughout California; and

WHEREAS, The Knight Initiative is but another veiled attack by California religious right wing groups to scapegoat Queer communities for larger political ends; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Zachary Shore has been the presiding pastor at the Most Holy Redeemer Catholic Church in San Francisco for the past eleven years and ministers to a primarily gay and lesbian congregation, wrote to Archbishop William Levada objecting; and Supervisors Ammiano, Leno, Katz, Bierman

WHEREAS, Reverend Shore wrote to the Archbishop of San Francisco expressing deep concern and displeasure at the San Francisco Archdiocese's monetary contribution to the Knight Initiative campaign and its adverse impact on his gay/lesbian/bisexual/transgender parishioners; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco Archbishop Levada's statements of support for the Knight Initiative has caused hurt, frustration and antipathy, especially amongst gay and lesbian Catholic parishioners; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby commend the Reverend Zachary Shore of the Most Holy Redeemer Catholic Church for his courage and compassion in expressing opposition to the Archdiocese of San Francisco's financial contribution to the anti-gay Knight Initiative; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commend the Reverend Zachary Shore for being responsive, compassionate, and standing up for his lesbian and gay parishioners.
