8 chemicals used on public property, and

9 WHEREAS, As a sign of this commitment, the City and County of San
10 Francisco has enacted a model Integrated Pest Management Ordinance (IPM), and

11 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health has adopted a comprehensive
12 and innovative IPM implementation program for all properties under its jurisdiction;
13 and,

14 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health has worked in communities
15 throughout the City to control pests through education, prevention and non-chemical
16 means; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health has created and maintained a
18 beautiful landscaped area around San Francisco General Hospital without the use
19 of chemical pesticides; and,

20 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health has demonstrated outstanding
21 leadership in creating a successful IPM program and serves as an invaluable
22 resource for other departments; now, therefore, be it

23 **RESOLVED**, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors acknowledges
24 and commends the Department of Public Health for its outstanding leadership in
25 reducing the use of pesticides and other toxic chemicals on City property.




