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11	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
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13	Section 1. Chapter 15 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding
14	Section 15.19, to read as follows:
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16	SEC. 15.19. RECOVERY FIRST DRUG POLICY.
17	(a) Title. This Section 15.19 shall be known as the "Recovery First Drug Policy."
18	(b) Definitions. For purposes of this Section 15.19, the following terms have the following
19	<u>meanings:</u>
20	(1) "Recovery" means abstinence from illicit drugs, and shall include participation
21	in a Medication-Assisted-Treatment program administered by a qualified healthcare provider in
22	accordance with applicable laws and medical guidance.
23	(2) "Substance Use Disorder" has the meaning set forth in the 5th edition of the
24	American Psychiatric Association's Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, as may be
25	amended or revised from time to time.

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2	(c) Policy. The cessation of illicit drug use and attainment of long-term Recovery from
3	Substance Use Disorders shall be the primary objective of the City's drug policy.
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5	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
6	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
7	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
8	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
