Overview of Grant



Proposed Approach for Implementing Modular Approach to Therapy for Children with Anxiety, Depression, Trauma, or Conduct Problems (MATCH):

- **Amount:** \$750,000
- **Timeline:** October 4, 2024 – June 30, 2025
- **Funder:** CA Department of Healthcare Services via Heluna Health
- **Grant Summary:** Support trauma-informed programs and evidence-based practices to increase access to child and youth behavioral services

Grant Summary



Grant will support the implementation of a **trauma-informed program and evidence-based practice** to increase access to services that address behavioral health needs and the impact of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs):

- **MATCH** is a modular and flexible model that tailors Cognitive Behavioral Therapy to the specific needs of youth ages 6-17 experiencing trauma, anxiety, depression, and/or conduct problems. This will serve **384 youth** and their families by June 2025.
- The implementation team at UCSF ICAP will train **24 mental health professionals**, at community clinics, as MATCH providers and certify 7 professionals as MATCH Supervisors, enhancing our capacity to deliver and sustain effective mental health services.

Retroactivity



We are seeking **retroactive authorization** to accept this grant.

- SFDPH received notice of this grant on October 4, 2024, on the first day of the grant term.
- DPH brought this item to the BOS after going through the fiscal approvals process, including Controller's Office review and approval.
