Proposed Approach for Implementing Modular Approach to Therapy for Children with Anxiety, Depression, Trauma, or Conduct Problems (MATCH):

- **Amount:** \$750,000
- Timeline: October 4, 2024 June 30, 2025
- Funder: CA Department of Healthcare Services via Heluna Health
- Grant Summary: Support trauma-informed programs and evidence-based practices to increase access to child and youth behavioral services

Grant Summary



Grant will support the implementation of a trauma-informed program and evidence-based practice to increase access to services that address behavioral health needs and the impact of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs):

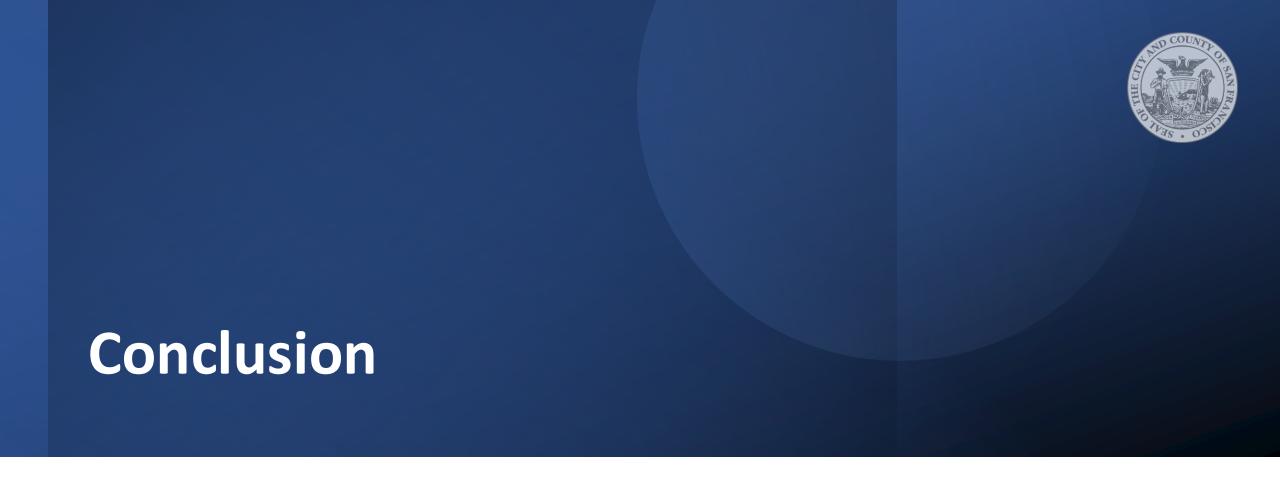
- MATCH is a modular and flexible model that tailors Cognitive Behavioral Therapy to the specific needs of youth ages 6-17 experiencing trauma, anxiety, depression, and/or conduct problems. This will serve **384 youth** and their families by June 2025.
- The implementation team at UCSF ICAP will train 24 mental health professionals, at community clinics, as MATCH providers and certify 7 professionals as MATCH Supervisors, enhancing our capacity to deliver and sustain effective mental health services.
