8 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors, in accordance with Administrative Code section
9 6.37, is required to fix the highest general prevailing rate of wages, including wages paid for
10 holiday and overtime work, for various crafts and kinds of labor as paid for similar work in
11 private employment in the City and County of San Francisco; and

12 WHEREAS, The Civil Service Commission at its meeting of October 19, 1998, certified
13 and forwarded to the Board of Supervisors data as to the highest general prevailing rate of
14 wages, including wages paid for holiday and overtime work, for various crafts and kinds of
15 labor as paid for similar work in private employment in the City and County of San Francisco;

18 RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the data certified by the Civil


